HOW DO I ACCESS IT? ► FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT IS A PROCESS AND IS DESIGNED TO BE ONGOING.

► FORMATIVE ASSESSMENT SHOULD BE EMBEDDED IN REGULAR INSTRUCTION TO BE EFFECTIVE.

► THE OBJECTIVE IS TO PROVIDE FEEDBACK TO BOTH THE TEACHER AND THE STUDENT.

► THE GOAL IS TO ADJUST INSTRUCTION, BASED ON THE FEEDBACK GATHERED, TO MEET STUDENTS' SPECIFIC LEARNING NEEDS.
