

REaD Carpet Ready Program Fact Sheet

- · Workshops are designed to provide families with the tools necessary to facilitate reading activities at home.
- Educators dressed as book characters and red carpet celebrities lead parents and students through a series of research-based activities that families can do at home to support reading practice.
- The red carpet theme uses analogies that help parents readily grasp key reading concepts.
- The workshop content covers all five components of reading: phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary and comprehension.
- Workshops last approximately 1.5 hours.
- Curriculum is aligned with English Language Arts Florida Standards (LAFS).
- Families follow along with the presentation via a program-style workbook.
- Families are encouraged to hang their workbook up when they return home as a visual prompt to follow through with reading activities and practice.
- Workshops are created and supported by the Florida Department of Education's Just Read, Florida! office and Bureau of Family and Community Outreach.
