## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Changes are proposed to insert definition that was inadvertently omitted during the prior rule making process relating to instructional personnel as follows:

"Out-of-field" means a teacher is assigned to a course covering subject matter outside the field for which the teacher holds a certificate per Section 1012.55, F.S., or for which the teacher has not demonstrated sufficient subject matter expertise per Section 1012.42, F.S., and as determined by subsection (2)(a) - (h) of this rule.

#### 6A-1.0503 Definition of Qualified Instructional Personnel.

- (1) As used in this rule, the following terms have the following meanings:
- (a) through (b) No change.
- (c) "Out-of-field" means a teacher is assigned to a course covering subject matter outside the field for which the teacher holds a certificate per Section 1012.55, F.S., or for which the teacher has not demonstrated sufficient subject matter expertise per Section 1012.42, F.S., and as determined by paragraphs (2)(a)-(h) of this rule.
