Submission: Schools are invited to enter the contest online at: [2019 Dads Take Your Child to School Day Contest](#).

Items included on survey are:

- District
- School Name
- Principal Name
- School Type
- Total number of dads, father figures, and role models who participated
- Total school student population
- Description of activity or activities held and its impact on students
- Evidence of participation

Contact: Participating schools must designate one person per school to submit entry for the contest. Name, position/title, email address and phone number of the person submitting the entry must be included.

Eligibility: Evidence of participation in activities for Dads Take Your Child to School Day to support your entry is required. Examples include, but are not limited to: sign-in sheets, name tags, photos, or other. Do not include items for unrelated school activities. Incomplete entries will not be considered.

Timeframe: Contest link will open on **September 26, 2019** and close **October 10, 2019**.

Selection: Winning school will be selected based on the information provided.
