Summary of Changes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ New data element intended to capture whether the learner is employed, not employed, or not in the labor force at time of entry into the adult education program in the current term/semester. Includes five new codes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - New Code (E) Employed- Learners, who work as paid employees, work at their own business or farm, or who work 15 hours or more per week as unpaid workers at a farm or business operated by a member of their family. Includes learners who are not currently working but who have jobs or businesses from which they are temporarily absent. - New Code (U) Unemployed- Learners who are not employed but are seeking employment, make specific efforts to find a job, and are available to work. - New Code (N) Not in the Labor Force- Learners who are not employed and are not seeking employment. - New Code (X) Not Available (This is a temporary value, to be discontinued beginning with Winter/Spring reporting for 2014-15 reporting year) - New Code (Z) Not Applicable- Learner is not enrolled in a National Reporting System (NRS) eligible Adult General Education program.
Additional Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Only required for students enrolled in Adult General Education programs that are NRS Eligible ▪ Status should be collected at the beginning of each term/semester. If student is enrolled in two or more terms in a reporting period, employment status reported should be for the first term/semester. ▪ Not available should only be reported for terms/semesters that begin prior to agency implementation of the new element. It is expected that by Spring Enrollment, all agencies will have collected employment status for any new or continuing adult education student.
