SUBJECT: Perkins IV 2012-13 Local Level Data Review

The Perkins IV 2012-13 Consolidated Annual Report (CAR) collects state annual enrollment, performance accountability and financial status reports on the Perkins State Basic Grant (Title I), as authorized by the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006, 20 U.S.C. 2301 et seq. as amended by P.L. 109-270 (Perkins IV or the Act).

In order to ensure data reliability, a website has been developed that will facilitate local review of 2012-2013 Perkins IV data. As a reminder, states and locals are accountable for all secondary measures during 2012-2013 as delineated in the charts below (unless your district negotiated a different target for 2012-2013).

6S1-Nontraditional Participation	31%	37.13%
6S2-Nontraditional Completion	97%	95.72%

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While we will not be able to allow re-submissions of survey data, this review will provide an opportunity for you to identify computer programming or calculation errors. In order to access the Florida Department of Education Perkins IV CAR Data tool, go to <https://app1.fldoe.org/PerkinsData/DataTool.aspx>. To view data, select 2012-2013 from the drop-down menu, select agency type and then your agency. You can then click on the “submit” button which will produce data results. The results include the numerator, denominator and calculated percentage for all of the performance measures. The tool includes an option to view state-level data on all measures as well.

I would strongly encourage local administrators and data reports coordinators to review the 2012-2013 Perkins IV data for accuracy and provide feedback on any detected errors by 5 p.m. January 31, 2014, to Tara Goodman at tara.goodman@fldoe.org or at 850-245-9002.
