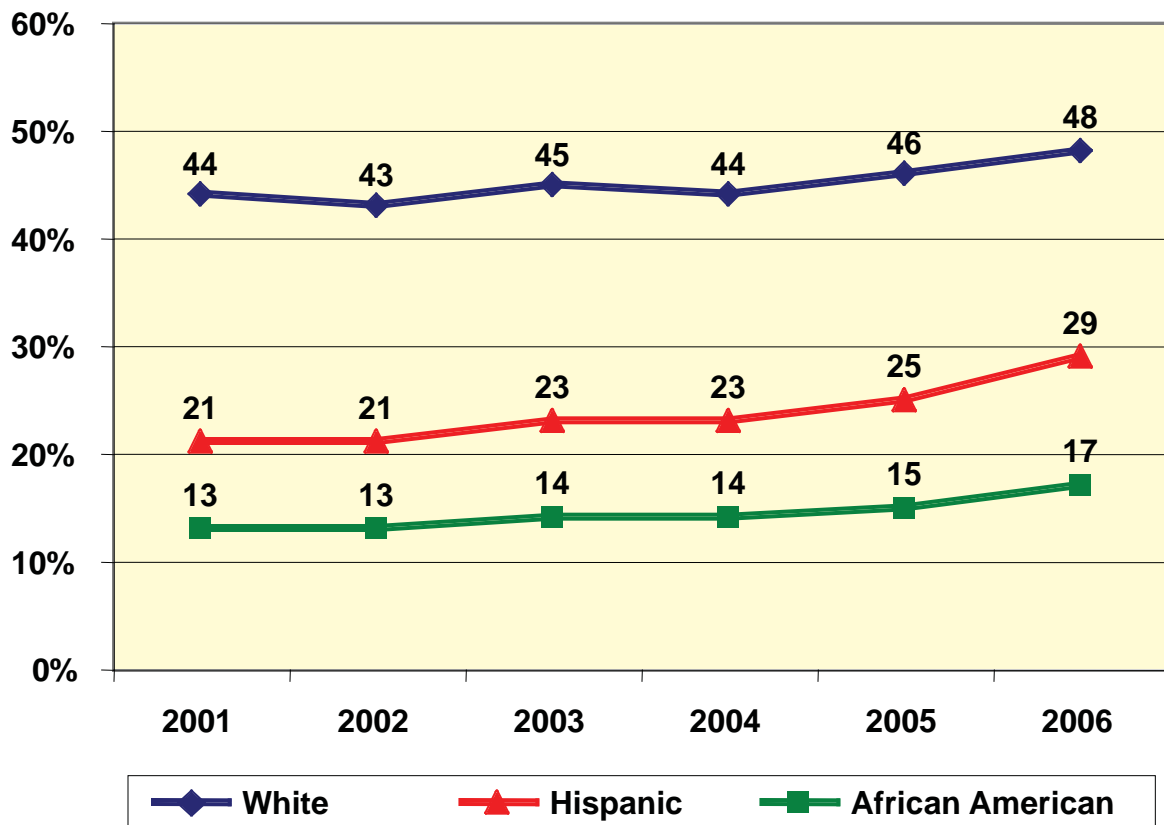


High Schools FCAT Reading Achievement Level 3 and Above (On Grade Level and Above) Grades 9 and 10



In 2006, 48 percent of white students in grades 9 and 10 were performing at or above achievement level 3 (on grade level) on FCAT Reading. This is an increase from 44 percent in 2001, 43 percent in 2002, 45 percent in 2003, 44 percent in 2004, and 46 percent in 2005. In 2006, 29 percent of Hispanic students in grades 9 and 10 were performing at or above achievement level 3 (on grade level) on FCAT Reading. This is an increase from 21 percent in 2001, 21 percent in 2002, 23 percent in 2003, 23 percent in 2004, and 25 percent in 2005. In 2006, 17 percent of African American students in grades 9 and 10 were performing at or above achievement level 3 (on grade level) on FCAT Reading. This is an increase from 13 percent in 2001, 13 percent in 2002, 14 percent in 2003, 14 percent in 2004, and 15 percent in 2005.
