## What is the Florida College System?

The Florida College System is a network of 28 community colleges, colleges and state colleges serving nearly a million Floridians.

It is the primary access point to higher education for Floridians, offering an array of programs designed to prepare students for entry into the workforce or opportunities to continue their education.

Housing within the Florida College System (FCS) is predominately off campus and provided through a third party. Few FCS institutions manage their own residence facilities or have on-campus housing. Colleges were initially designed to accommodate commuter students; therefore, on-campus housing was limited or nonexistent.

Currently some FCS institutions provide housing for specific student populations such as international students, student athletes or specific scholarship recipients. However, affordable housing can generally be found close to most campuses.
