APPROVED MIDDLE SCHOOL COURSES FOR CAREER & EDUCATION PLANNING 2020-2021 School Year

Per <u>Section 1003.4156</u>, <u>Florida Statutes (F.S.)</u>, for students to meet middle grades promotion requirements, a Career and Education Planning course must be completed. At a minimum, the course must be Internet-based, customizable to each student and include researched-based assessments to assist students in determining educational and career options and goals. The Florida career and education planning program will satisfy the above requirement as it is Internet-based, it is customizable to each student and contains research-based assessments to assist with education and career goals.

The Career and Education Planning course must result in a completed personalized academic and career plan for the student, that may be revised as the student progresses through middle and high school; must emphasize the importance of entrepreneurship and employability skills; and must include information from the Department of Economic Opportunity's economic security report under <u>s. 445.07, F.S.</u> The required personalized academic and career plan must inform students of high school graduation requirements, including a detailed explanation of the requirements to earn a high school diploma designation (<u>s. 1003.4285, F.S.</u>); the requirements for each scholarship in the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program; state university and Florida College System institution admission requirements; and, available opportunities to earn college credit in high school, including Advanced Placement courses, the International Baccalaureate Program, the Advanced International Certificate of Education Program, dual enrollment (including career dual enrollment), and career education courses, including career-themed courses, preapprenticeship and apprenticeship programs, and course sequences that lead to an industry certification (pursuant to <u>s. 1003.492, F.S.</u>, or <u>s. 1008.44, F.S.</u>).

Schools must use one of the approved courses to meet this requirement. Some of the approved courses are designated as year-long. In those cases, the classroom teacher can determine which semester to implement the career and education planning standards.
