Students will be prompted to read silently for the first 15 minutes of each period <p>Wednesday</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">  Students can bring their favorite children’s story to share. ELA teachers will have students discuss plot, theme, protagonist, antagonist and other literary terms.
