Monday, January 23rd	The Neptune Project gamification trailer will be broadcast to students after morning announcements, to build interest and excitement about the upcoming reading/writing challenges. Mysterious signs have already been posted around the school to capture students' attention.
Tuesday, January 24 <sup>th</sup>	Students will embark on their first mission - to persuade at least 20 members from their classroom pod area to join their team. Student signups will take place.
Wednesday, January 25 <sup>th</sup>	Students will complete their second mission - using clues from Sunshine State Reader Books, students will decode the identity of a mystery staff member who can unlock the secret of their team name.
Thursday, January 26 <sup>th</sup>	Students will work on their third mission - together, team members will draft a team banner design and craft their pod team banner using provided supplies.
Friday, January 27 <sup>th</sup>	Student teams will begin competing against other teams to earn "XP" points for successful completion of reading/writing missions, challenges, and tasks focused on the various Sunshine State Reader Books, as well as separate, specific challenges based solely upon Polly Holyhoke's book, <a href="The Neptune Project">The Neptune Project</a> .
