<b>Monday, January 23rd</b>	Celebrate Literacy Week Kick-Off: The Baker County School District Superintendent will share a recording of herself reading a selection to our elementary students and a different recording of herself reading to our secondary students to kick off our week.
<b>Tuesday, January 24<sup>th</sup></b>	Guest Reader Day: Westside Elementary School will continue their annual Project REACH event, and all our schools will give students the opportunity to hear a guest reader.
