Students will discuss the story/book and talk about their favorite parts</p> <p>Wednesday</p> <p> Wear a Word Wednesday! - Students will wear a word of their choice around school. If stopped by another student or teacher, that student must share their word and its definition.</p> <p>Thursday</p>

	<p> Everyone wear red- Read Every Day- All students and staff will wear a red shirt and be ready to tell others why reading is important.</p> <p>Friday</p> <p> Character Day- Students will dress up as their favorite character from a book and during specials a few students will get go on stage and talk about their character. Every student that dresses up will get a bookmark.</p>
