Celebrate Literacy Week, Florida!

<p>Monday, January 22nd</p>	<p>Literary Loud Speaker-each morning a teacher or student will join in the morning announcements to read an excerpt of their favorite book.</p> <p>Poster Contest: A poster contest will begin on Monday, and winners will be announced on Friday. Teachers will create a poster representing the theme “Find Yourself in a Book.” Posters will be submitted anonymously and displayed in the media center. Students will vote on the best poster and winner will be announced on Friday.</p> <p>AR Quiz Drawing: Students who successfully pass an AR quiz during Literacy Week will have their names entered in a drawing for a book and a \$10 gift card to be awarded on Friday (2 winners per grade level).</p> <p>Daily Trivia: Every day during the morning announcements, students will have the opportunity to participate in an interactive poll where they can text their answer. The first person to get this correct will be the winner for the day, and will receive a prize.</p> <p>Selfie Book Cover Contest: Students will create a book cover including a selfie depicting the theme “Find Yourself in a Book.” On the back cover, they will write a synopsis about themselves as the main character in the book. Book covers will be submitted to the media specialist and displayed in the Media Center. An overall winner will be chosen and announced on Friday, and will receive a prize.</p> <p>The Book in Your Hall Contest-hall decorating contest. Students would choose a core content, themed book and decorate their halls. Math would select a math themed book, science a science themed book, etc.</p>
<p>Tuesday, January 23rd</p>	<p>Teacher Spotlight: Media students will video an interview with teachers about what their favorite books are and why. Teachers will promote reading through the sharing of personal experiences and encouraging words. They may also create a “trailer” for their favorite book.</p> <p>Student Infomercials: Students will create and share an infomercial promoting their favorite book. This will be done within ELA classes. After all students share in class, each teacher will choose one student to present his or her infomercial on the morning announcements.</p> <p>Bingo for Books at the elementary schools. Students and their families will join us for dinner and bingo. For every bingo students receive, they are able to select a new book to take home.</p>
<p>Wednesday, January 24th</p>	<p>DEAR (Drop Everything and Read): Science teachers will read aloud for 20 minutes a book of science-related, fictional content.</p> <p>Crazy Sock Day: Reading Rocks! Wear silly socks! Reading Rocks wear some crazy socks.</p> <p>AR Book Walk: A Book Walk will be set up around campuses using a short fiction story chosen for its plot. Students read the story as they walk. They are then able to take an AR test on the selection and discuss the plot when they return.</p>
