January 28th**

**Wednesday,
January 30th**

Wild About Reading Wednesday- Wear your wacky, tacky, mixed-matched clothes and share your love of reading by buddy reading with a classmate.

Suggested Random Act of Reading: Choose a favorite book and select a chapter, section, or scene that "changed your views" as a reader and create an illustrated cover for a music CD created for your book.



**Thursday,
January 31st**

Reading Makes Us Super Smart Day! - wear super hero attire or symbols to show that we know that the more we read, the more we know!

Suggested Random Act of Reading: Choose a favorite book and select a chapter, section, or scene that "changed your views" as a reader and draw a cartoon with at least 4 cells which tells the continuation or “the next day” of your book.



**Friday,
February 1st**

Wear your "school appropriate" pajamas and bring your favorite book for your Booknic Reading Event-take your classes outside to enjoy reading like a “picnic” or “booknic.” Students can read a favorite book and write about why it is their favorite.



Options for week long activities:

- Mystery Readers: Parents, staff members, community members, and friends will be invited into classrooms to read to students.
- Teachers, faculty, and staff will participate in “Favorite Book Selfies”, those photos will be featured on the morning show, and media center bulletin board to encourage students to try new books recommended by teachers.
