Tuesday, January 29	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pop-Up Book Exchange in the media center. - School-wide Reading Buddy Time - Poem in Your Pocket Day- Carry a poem in your pocket to read to anyone who asks.
Wednesday, January 30	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Guest Readers on the morning announcements discussing their favorite books. - Students will participate in creative digital storytelling using gaming methods. - Dress up as your favorite character from literature.
Thursday, January 31	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Family Reading Night. - “Today a Reader, Tomorrow a Leader”- Dress for the job you want! - Kindness Chain- Students will read a book about kindness, make a commitment to complete an act of random kindness, and add their name to the school’s kindness chain.
