Adventure awaits traveling the USA reading about America! • Students will be given a travel bag with a Reading Passport, Book Marker, gum and candy. During the week they will document their readings and get their passport stamped. • Teachers will decorate their doors depicting the theme, “BOOK Your Trip! Adventure Awaits!” and the doors will be judged – there will be a first, second and third place winner. • Three classes will take an adventurous trip to the reading coach’s room to be read a campfire story and make s’mores.
<p align="center">Tuesday, January 28th</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • LES will dress from the olden days - 100th day of school. Book your trip by covered wagon, horse or mule. Adventure awaits when reading historical fiction or nonfiction. • Sixteen more classes will take an adventurous trip to the reading coach’s room to be read a campfire story and make s’mores.
<p align="center">Wednesday, January 29th</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Athletic, hiking, or outdoor attire will be worn. Book a hiking trip or bicycle trip! Adventure awaits as we visit national, state and local parks. • The final fourteen classes will take an adventurous trip to the reading coach’s room to be read a campfire story and make s’mores. • All faculty, students, and staff will hike to the front lawn to enjoy 30 minutes of reading just prior to boarding the buses to go home.
<p align="center">Thursday, January 30th</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Nautical or aeronautical attire will be worn today. Book a trip by boat or plane to another country. Adventure awaits as we read stories, articles, or poems pertaining to other countries.
<p align="center">Friday, January 31st</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Welcome home! It is Pajama Day! Get comfortable and let the books take you where they may. Adventure awaits in every book to be read! • How many books can you read today? How many places can you go?

Week Long Activities:

- A world map, US map, and Florida map will be placed in the cafeteria for students to pin their passage setting.
- Directional posts with wooden arrows will be placed at various locations with genres and book titles written on the arrows.
- In the main office of the school, a display will be set up depicting the theme for Celebrate Literacy Week, Florida!, “BOOK Your Trip! Adventure Awaits!”
- Daily displays will be placed on the stage in the cafeteria, based on the daily Book adventure.
- Students will travel to other teachers’ classes within their grade level for other teachers to read to them.
