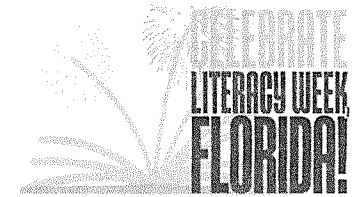

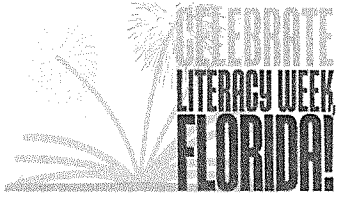
<b>Calendar of Events</b>	<b>Activity Title</b>	<b>What will students/staff will do?</b>
<b>Monday 1/27/20</b>	<b>Door Decorating</b>	As a class, students will pick their favorite class book or book they are currently reading. The teacher will use student work to decorate doors, windows, etc. based on their class' selection. Admin will be the judges and announce the winner on Friday, Jan. 31.  *Read a short bio of various authors on the morning show program, and display books by that author in the media center for students to check out and/or view in their classroom.
<b>Tuesday 1/28/20</b>	<b>Sock it to Reading</b>	Wear bright, colorful, and/or silly socks to school in support of literacy.  *An admin team member will be a guest speaker on the morning show to share and read one of their favorite childhood stories.
<b>Wednesday 1/29/20</b>	<b>Read Aloud Day</b>	Teachers will read their favorite read-a-loud or chapter book to their class and do an activity with it.  *Get Caught Reading: Admin will walk around if you are caught reading, you may receive a bookmark!
<b>Thursday 1/30/20</b>	<b>Be A Good Sport and Read!</b>	Wear your favorite team clothing to school in support of literacy.  *Morning Mystery Reader on the Morning Show.
<b>Friday 1/31/20</b>	<b>Reading Racers</b>	Pre-K through 1 <sup>st</sup> grade will get the chance to design their own STEM race car in the representation of their favorite story. We will have a "Reading Racer's Parade" and 2 <sup>nd</sup> - 5 <sup>th</sup> grade will create banners and support their peers during their parade.  *Morning Mystery Reader on the Morning Show.

Dates	Activity Title	Brief description of planned activity...
<b>Monday</b> 1/27/20	Featured Character Postcard	After reading a book, students will use a fun postcard template to describe their favorite character, including their favorite piece of dialogue.
<b>Tuesday</b> 1/28/20	Text Dependent Question	Student can choose or teacher may pick a text dependent question from a list of questions. The student will use that question as a focus for reading independently.
<b>Wednesday</b> 1/29/20	Making Predictions	Plan to read independently, pay attention and notice when you find yourself making a prediction. When you do, write down your prediction, note whether your prediction was correct.
<b>Thursday</b> 1/30/20	Say Something	Students pair up after reading, decide who will say something first. When you say something, do one or more of the following: Make a prediction, ask a question, clarify something you didn't understand. If you can't do one of these, then you need to reread.
<b>Friday</b> 1/31/20	Book Report All above activities will be done with independent reading for 20 mins.	After reading a book, do book report: Title, author, illustrator, characters, summary, opinion, favorite part.

<b>Monday</b> 1/27/20	Library Highlights	Visit to the school by the Belleview Public Library to highlight special programs provided in the community. This will be aired on the morning show and information sent home to parents.
<b>Tuesday</b> 1/28/20	Book Talks	Faculty member to conduct a brief book talk on the morning show to model how it is done for students.
