Friday, January 31	<p><u>Buddy Day</u>: Students can bring a stuffed animal or action figure to set on their desk while they are reading.</p> <p>Share a good book!</p> <p>Let students google a favorite book and listen to it. Put "video" in front of the title. Monitor.</p> <p>Desk Buddy: Students read silently or softly to their reading buddy during the day.</p>

We hope all teachers will help with the Bingo event. Please let Debbie and Renea know how you like to help.

Literacy Poster Contest: Rules are given to grades 3-5 students the week before. The top 3 winners in each grade will get a free book.

Monday January 27	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Million Minute Marathon – Students will read for 15 minutes during HOMEROOM (report how many students read to Mrs. Seley via email before the end of HOMEROOM) • “Adventure” Book Themed Door Deco - AVID students will begin decorating during 2nd period.
Tuesday January 28	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “Adventure” Book Inspired Sock/T-Shirt Day – Wear your favorite book/character socks or shirt (count will take place during 1st period Email results to Mrs. Seley before the end of 1st period).
