SUBJECT: 2012-2013 Carl D. Perkins Revised Allocations

The Division of Career and Adult Education (Division) received notification on May 2, 2012, from the U. S. Department of Education, Office of Vocational and Adult Education (OVAE), that Florida's Carl D. Perkins 2012-2013 state allocation has been increased.

In order to receive the revised 2012-2013 Carl D. Perkins allocations, eligible agencies must submit to the Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) a revised budget to reflect the increased amount. Eligible agencies must complete a new DOE 101 Budget Narrative Form "Increase Funds Only" to reflect the additional funds. The revised allocation charts reflecting the increased funds for school districts, career and technical centers, and colleges are located on the Division's website: <http://www.fldoe.org/workforce/dwdgrants/default.asp>.

These funds are to be treated as basic grant funds and used during the 2012-2013 fiscal year to support activities, provided such activities are reflected in the agency's approved plan.
