SUBJECT: Perkins IV 2010-2011 Local Level Data Review

The Perkins IV 2010-2011 Consolidated Annual Report (CAR) was submitted to the U.S. Department of Education by December 31, 2011. The CAR report collects state annual enrollment, performance accountability, and financial status reports on the Perkins State Basic Grant (Title I) as authorized by the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006, 20 U.S.C. 2301 et seq. as amended by P.L. 109-270 (Perkins IV or the Act).

In order to ensure data reliability, a website has been developed that will facilitate local review of 2010-2011 Perkins IV data. As a reminder, states and local agencies are accountable for all secondary measures during 2010-2011 as delineated in the charts below:

To access the Florida Department of Education's Perkins IV Consolidated Annual Report (CAR) Data Tool, go to <https://app1.fldoe.org/PerkinsData/DataTool.aspx>. While we will not be able to allow re-submissions of survey data, this review will provide an opportunity for you to identify computer programming or calculation errors. To view data, select 2010-2011 from the drop-down menu, select agency type, and then your agency. You can then click on the "submit" button which will produce data results. The results include the numerator, denominator and calculated percentage for all of the performance measures. The tool includes an option to view state-level data on all measures as well.

Additionally, you may reference the 2010-2011 Perkins IV Performance Accountability Guidelines and Operational Procedures located on the Perkins IV implementation website for more technical details related to the measurement approaches and the student definitions of participants and concentrators.

I would strongly encourage local administrators and data reports coordinators to review the 2010-2011 preliminary Perkins IV data for accuracy and provide feedback on any detected errors.
