## **MEMORANDUM**

**SUBJECT:** Industry Certification - Additional FTE in the 2010-11 Florida Education Finance

Program (FEFP) Calculation

The Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP) includes additional full-time equivalent (FTE) membership in the calculation for students who earn industry certifications in career and professional academies and who graduate with a standard diploma. Based on the requirements in s. 1011.62(1)(p), F.S. and Rule 6A-6.0573(6), F.A.C., all of the following conditions must be met for the additional full-time equivalent membership funding for an "earning" industry certification:

Student is enrolled in a registered career and professional academy. Student completes a certification on the "Industry Certification Funding List." Student receives a standard high school diploma.

The Department of Education has completed the 3rd calculation of the 2010-11 FEFP.

One eligible student generates 0.3 FTE in the calculation. You can calculate the number of students who generated the additional FTE by dividing your district's FTE total by 0.3.
