This letter comprises the final report for Putnam County School District's 2010–11Spring Cycle Level 2 self-assessment process for exceptional student education (ESE) compliance. The district identified no incidents of noncompliance; the Bureau's review of a sampling of records validated the district's results.

The self-assessment system is designed to address the major areas of compliance related to the State Performance Plan (SPP)/Annual Performance Report (APR) required under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). The results of district self-assessments are included in the State's APR and are used to inform oversight activities, including the selection of districts for on-site monitoring, and the local educational agency (LEA) determinations required under Section 300.603, Title 34, Code of Federal Regulations, which result in districts being identified as "meets requirements," "needs assistance," "needs intervention," or "needs substantial intervention."

The district assessed 55 different standards within ten student records.
