#### Intel® Teach

The North East Florida Educational Consortium, in cooperation with the Florida Department of Education, Heartland Educational Consortium, and Panhandle Area Educational Consortium are proud to announce the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Educator and 21<sup>st</sup> Century Educator Leader Certificates in partnership with the Intel® Teach Affiliate program.
