




#### Average ACT Composite Score Last 5 Years

From 2017 to 2018, African American SAT average scores went from 911 in 2017 to 916 in 2018.




### Advanced Placement

- Compared to the other states, Florida has the highest percentage of graduates who took an AP exam during high school (55.9%).
- Florida's 2018 graduates have the third highest AP success rate in the nation with 31.7 percent scoring a 3 or higher on an AP exam during high school, moving up from 4<sup>th</sup> place in 2017.
- The percentage of Florida graduates who succeeded on AP exams is
   8.2 percentage points higher than the national average (23.5%).
- Compared to 2017 graduates, Florida's AP participation rate increased
   1.3 percentage points and the success rate increased 0.9 percentage points.
- A majority of Florida's 2018 graduates who took an AP exam during high school also passed an AP exam.
- Florida is ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> in the nation for improvement over the past 10 years in the percentage of graduates scoring 3 or higher on the AP exam during high school, improving by 12.4 percentage points during the last decade.
