On December 12, 2012, the State Board of Education established new Achievement Level standards for the Geometry End-of-Course (EOC) Assessment. The Spring 2012 Geometry EOC Assessment scores were reported as T scores. The Spring 2012 results have been converted to the new score scale and are being provided based on the new standards so that stakeholders and the general public are able to see what they would have been if the new score scale and Achievement Levels had been approved and implemented at that time.
