Greetings Colleagues,

The Department of Education plans to initiate [rule development](#) for a newly proposed rule, Rule 6A-14.094, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The new rule will allow Florida College System institutions to propose specialized associate in arts transfer degrees that will support students who need supplemental lower-level coursework for admission into a university baccalaureate degree program beyond the 60 semester hours required for the general associate in arts degree.

Additionally, Rule 6A-14.0303, F.A.C. and Rule 6A-14.030, F.A.C. are being amended to include the newly created specialized associate in arts transfer degree among the degrees with general education requirements. Other technical changes for clarity and consistency will be made to the rules as well.
