- Oakland Terrace School For The Visual And Performing Arts

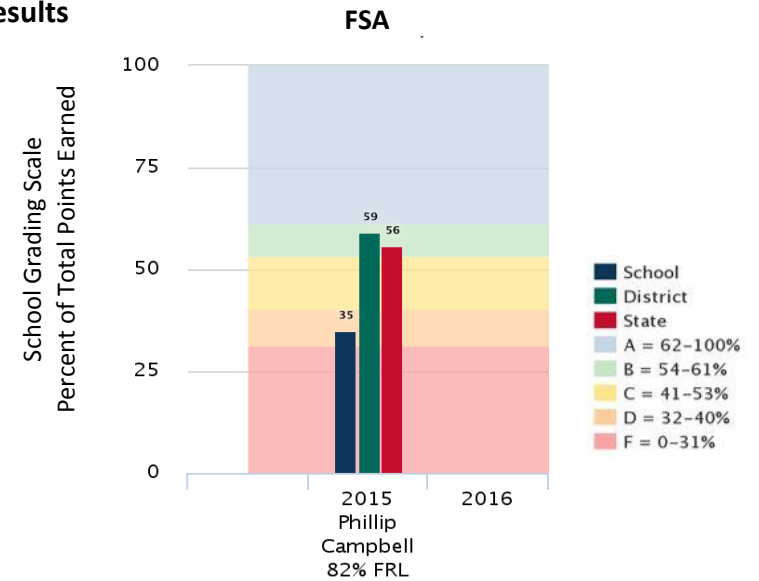
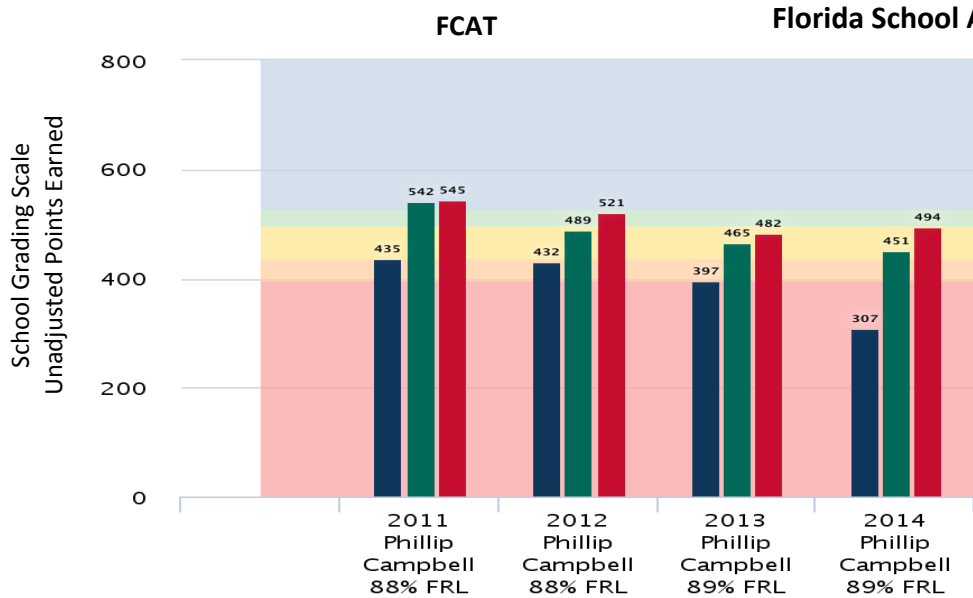

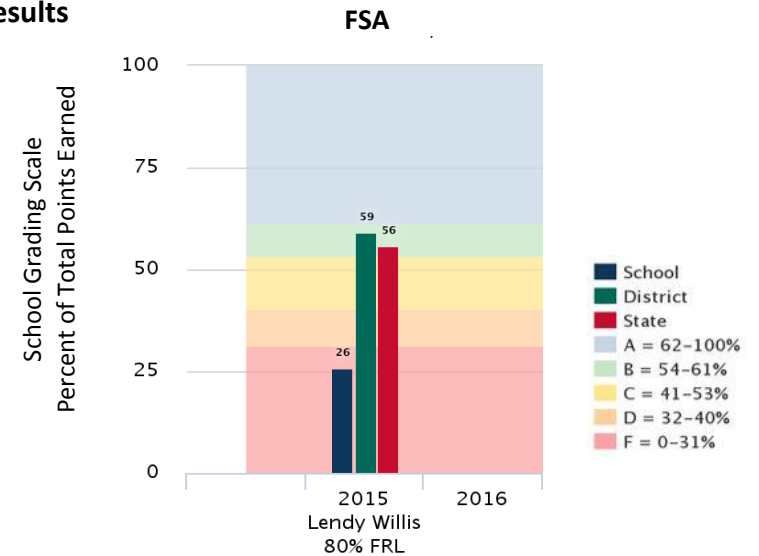
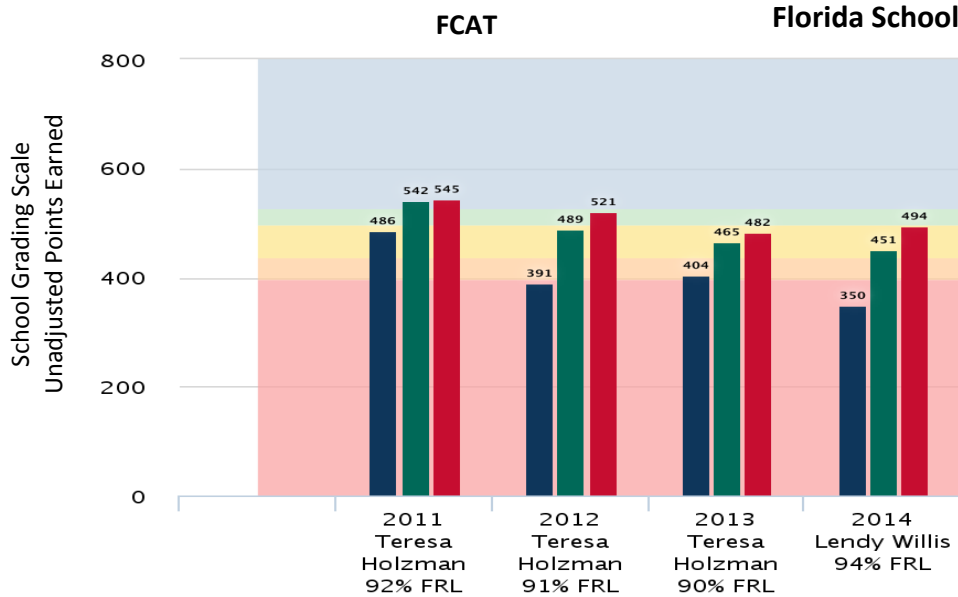
Student Enrollment History
