EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This rule is being repealed as statutory authority to establish policies and standards for performance expectations, graduated sanctions and consequences for education programs in the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) was repealed in s. 1003.51(2), F.S., by House Bill 1425 (2024) and Senate Bill 7004 (2024). Starting with the 2024-25 school year, Department of Juvenile Justice day treatment and prevention schools will earn an alternative school improvement rating.
