EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of these rule amendments is to reflect the updates of section 1003.5716, F.S., passed during the 2024 Legislative Session. A student with an individual educational plan (IEP) and his or her parents must be provided information on self-determination and the legal responsibilities regarding the educational decisions that transfer to the student upon age 18. The proposed rule amendment will include supported decisionmaking agreements, as provided in section 709.2209, F.S., in the required information provided to students with disabilities and their parents.
