## 6A-6.0787 Ballot Process for Teacher and Parent Voting for Charter School Conversion Status.

An application be proposing to convert an existing public school to a charter school must demonstrate the support of teachers and parents in accordance with Section 1002.33(3)(b), F.S. The following provisions are established to detail the ballot process by which such support shall be demonstrated.

- (1) through (2) No change.
- (3) Ballot results.
- (a) through (c) No change.
- (d) If <u>at least fifty (50) percent</u> a <u>majority</u> of teachers employed at the school and <u>at least fifty (50) percent</u> a <u>majority</u> of voting parents support the charter proposal, <u>provided that a majority of parents eligible to vote</u> <u>participate in the process pursuant to (5)(d)</u>, the conversion charter application must be submitted during the same calendar year the vote is held. <u>If this voting threshold is not met</u>, an application may not be submitted to the sponsor.
- (e) If a majority of parents and/or teachers do not support the charter proposal, the application may not be submitted to the sponsor.
  - (e)(f) Only one (1) vote per calendar year may be held.
  - (4) through (5) No change.
