# FFEA Chapter Display Competition

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## OVERVIEW:

- This is a chapter competition. Chapters will develop a display to feature their chapter's mission and activities. The Chapter Display will be showcased throughout the conference. All chapters attending the conference are eligible to participate.

## TOPIC:

- Feature the chapter and school and incorporate the conference theme, "Lights, Camera, Teach!"

## ELIGIBILITY:

- Each chapter may submit only one display.
- Displays are to be created and assembled by student members.

## GUIDELINES:

- The display is intended to feature the chapter and school. Entries should also incorporate the conference theme, "Lights, Camera, Teach!"
- Displays must fit on a standard 6-foot table. Any items on the floor will not be considered a part of the display.
- Displays must clearly identify the school name.
- All items will be arranged on tables provided by the hotel.
- All Chapter Displays will need to be removed from the ballroom on Sunday, February 2, 2025, after the closing session.
- The following are optional items and will NOT impact your score.
  - Chapter representatives are encouraged to bring small gifts for distribution to student members from other FFEA chapters. Gifts may include, but are not limited to, pens, pencils, stickers, crafts, tokens, candy, etc. It is recommended that each chapter bring 600 items in order to ensure that each conference participant will receive a gift.
  - Scrapbooks may be included with the chapter display.

## SCORING:

- Only the Chapter Display will be scored using the attached rubric. The maximum total number of points possible is 16.
- The top three winners will be announced during the closing session on Sunday, February 2, 2025.

**\*Please note: Both high school and postsecondary entries will be scored within the same category based on the attached rubrics.**
