**Agreement Provisions:**

<b>Validation Mechanism:</b>
To be awarded the college credit guaranteed by this agreement, a student must enroll at a Florida College System institution in the associate degree program identified within the agreement and present the original applied technology diploma or an official transcript that delineates program completion.
<b>Applicability:</b>
Students entering the Associate degree program specified herein must meet the admissions requirements of the college and the program to which they are applying, as well as those of Rule 6A-10.0315(2), Florida Administrative Code.  The award of college credit as specified within this agreement is guaranteed if a student enrolls in the eligible associate degree program within three years of completing the ATD program. Credit may be awarded upon expiration of the agreement on a course-by-course basis at the discretion of the postsecondary institution.
