## Spring 2022 ACCESS for ELLs and Alternate ACCESS for ELLs

## Overview of Results

- The ACCESS for ELLs assessments are designed to measure Florida's English Language Learners (ELLs) proficiency in English.
- In the 2021-22 school year, 261,271 ELLs in grades K-12 took the ACCESS for ELLs as a paper-based assessment. Across all grades, 18\% of these students were proficient in English (see Table 11 for the comparison of percentage proficient in English for the past six administrations). The Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing domains have possible proficiency level scores up to 6.0.
- In the 2021-22 school year, 920 ELLs in grades 1-12 took the Alternate ACCESS for ELLs as a paperbased assessment. Across all grades, $44 \%$ of these students were proficient in English (see Table 11 for the comparison of percentage proficient in English for the past six administrations). The Listening, Reading and Speaking domains have possible proficiency level scores of up to P2 - Emerging, and the Writing domain has possible proficiency level scores of up to P3 - Developing.
