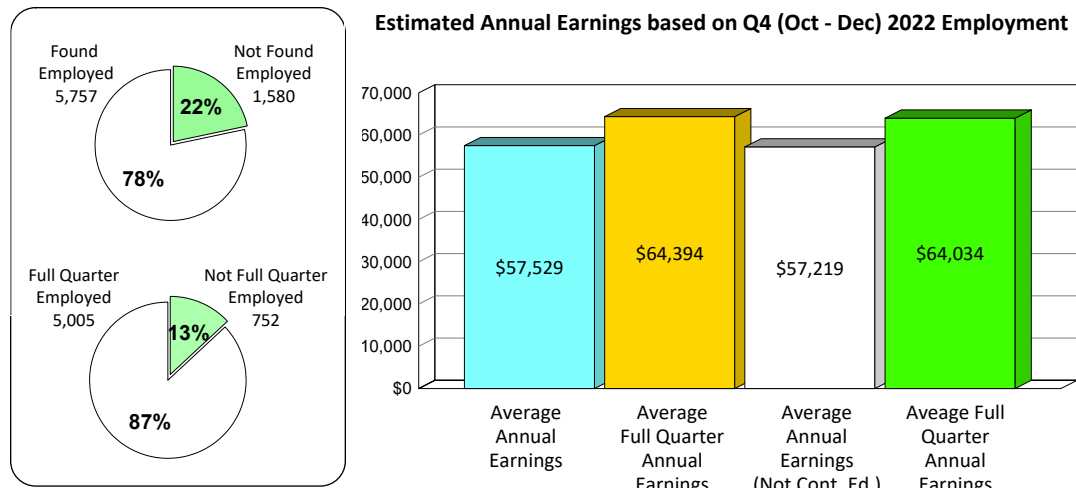

FLORIDA EMPLOYMENT DATA (ANNUALIZED WAGES)

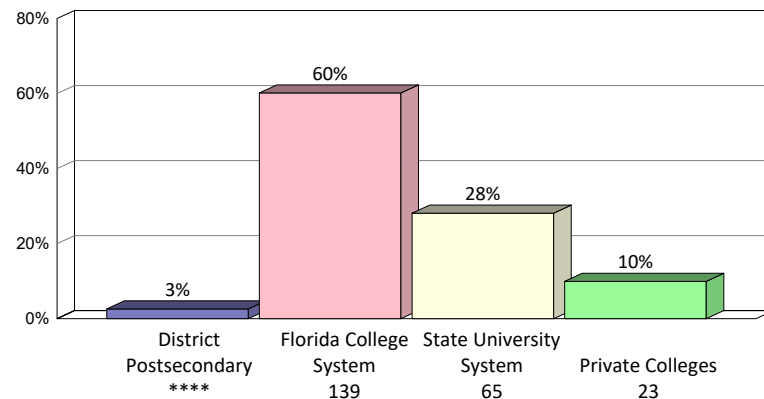
Estimated Annual Earnings based on Q4 (Oct - Dec) 2022 Employment

Total Continuing Education & Found Employed: 203 88%

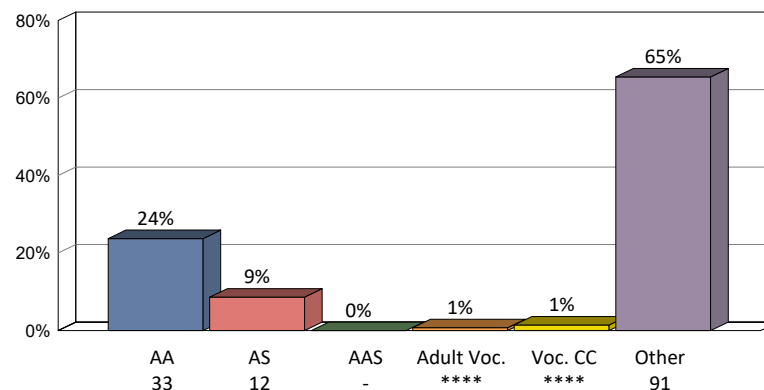
