The Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP) includes additional full-time equivalent (FTE) membership in the calculation for students who earned industry certifications while enrolled in registered career-themed courses. The Florida Department of Education has completed the 2023-24 FEFP, Third Calculation. This calculation is based on data submitted by districts for the 2022-23 reporting year.
