Remedial instruction is any course listed in the Course Code Directory as “remedial” or as “Level 1.”</li> <li>• Has secondary school grades below 2.0 on a 4.0 scale (Grade “A” equals 4.0).</li> <li>• Scored at or below the 25th percentile for the student’s grade level on a standardized achievement or aptitude test.</li> <li>• Failing a grade.</li> </ul>
