# Updates Made to the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) K-2 Alternatives for Students Who Are Deaf or Hard of Hearing (DHH)

FDOE's office of K-12 Student Assessment, in partnership with BEESS, has updated the 2024-25 K-2 Progress Monitoring Statewide Assessments Accommodations Guide to reflect paper-based accommodations for students with the DHH exceptionalities, specifically for FAST K-2 Reading and Mathematics. #### Restraint Data for September 2024 is Now Available

September 2024 data for restraint incidents submitted to the Involuntary Examination, Restraint, and Seclusion (known as IERS) web application is now available. The data have been posted to the <a href="Program Accountability">Program Accountability</a>, Assessments & Data Systems web page and can be located by scrolling down to the section titles "SWD Restraint Data – SY 2024-25," and selecting the appropriate month. Pursuant to section 1003.573(8), Florida Statutes, "The department shall maintain aggregate data of incidents of restraint and disaggregate the data for analysis by county,

school, student exceptionality, and other variables, including the type and method of restraint used. This information shall be updated monthly, deidentified, and made available to the public through the department's website."

# Tip of the Week

#### Have Teachers Track Students' Refusal of Services

Train teachers to document when and what services a student refused, how the teacher responded, the result of the response, student statements or teacher observations, and when to alert the individual educational plan team. This will shed light on why the student is refusing services. (Special Ed Connection®)
